



REGULAR MEETING

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of November 23, 2016 was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Klein in the Council Chambers at 6530 W. 79th Street in Burbank, Illinois .
- ROLL CALL** Roll call indicated the following Council members present: Alderman Foy, Contreras, Szymczak, Grider, Pacella, Piznarski and Pyle. Also present: Mayor Klein, Treasurer Viverito, Clerk Roach, and Attorney Joe Cainkar.
- The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag
- JOURNAL** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Contreras to approve the minutes of November 9, 2016 as presented was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Motion made by Alderman Grider seconded by Alderman Szymczak to approve the current list of bills. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays . Voting Aye: Alderman Contreras, Pacella, Grider, Szymczak, Piznarski, Pyle and Foy. The Chair declared the motion carried.
- CLERK'S REPORT** Clerk Roach reported that City Hall will be closed Thursday November 24th and Friday, November 25th in commemoration of the Thanksgiving day holiday.
- DEPT. OF ZONING** Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Pyle to authorize the attorney to prepare an ordinance for Petition 16-10-1 Mahde Mansur 8057 McVicker Burbank, Illinois 60459. The petitioner is requesting a variation to install a 6' privacy fence on front yard side set back. Approved by zoning. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderman Foy, Pacella, Grider, Szymczak, Piznarski, Pyle and Contreras. The Chair declared the motion carried.
- Alderman Foy made the motion seconded by Alderman Piznarski to authorize the attorney to prepare an ordinance for petition 16-10-2 for Para Builders and developers and Monica Mietus 8659 S. Sayre (Lots 2 and 3) Burbank Illinois 60459. The petitioner is requesting a request for lot 2 and lot 3 which are currently vacant and zoned single family be rezoned to two multi family two flats. Approved by Zoning with the stipulation of the privacy fence to be installed and maintained in the back as discussed. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderman Pacella, Foy, Grider, Contreras, Piznarski, Pyle and Szymczak. The Chair declared the motion carried.
- CITIZEN'S REPORT** Mayor Klein recognized John Przytula of 8500 Oak Park who wanted to know what men were doing on 85th street and was told by Tim Geary they were engineers estimating a paving project.
