- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of April 27, 2016 was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Klein in the Council Chambers at 6530 W. 79th street in Burbank, Illinois.
- ROLL CALL** Roll call indicated the following Council members present: Alderman Szymczak, Grider, Pacella, Piznarski, Foy, Looney, and Pyle. Also present: Mayor Klein, Deputy Clerk Chisholm and Attorney Vince Cainkar. Absent: Clerk Roach and Treasurer Viverito.
- The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
