



REGULAR MEETING
OF THE
BURBANK CITY COUNCIL
JUNE 28, 2017

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of June 28, 2017 was called to order at 7:30 PM by Alderman Robert Contreras in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79th Street Burbank, Illinois.
- ROLL CALL** Alderman Contreras requested a roll call which indicated the following members present: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski, Alderman Pyle, Clerk Szymczak and Attorney Vince Cainkar. Absent: Mayor Dan M. Foy and Treasurer Dean Viverito. Alderman Contreras then made a motion to appoint Alderman Jason Pyle as temporary Chair of the June 28th Council Meeting in Mayor Foy's absence. The motion was seconded by Alderman John Pacella. A roll call vote indicated 7 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella, Alderman Piznarski and Alderman Pyle.
- JOURNAL** Alderman Grider made a motion seconded by Alderman Contreras to approve the minutes of June 14, 2017. The motion was unanimously approved by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.
- CURRENT BILLS** Alderman Grider made a motion seconded by Alderwoman Gagle to approve the current list of bills. A roll call indicated 6 Ayes and 0 Nays. Voting Aye: Alderwoman Gagle, Alderman Contreras, Alderwoman Gustafson, Alderman Grider, Alderman Pacella and Alderman Piznarski.
