
Petition #21-06-3 Anup Daraji 8529 S. Leclaire Burbank, Il. requesting an appeal / reconsideration of decision by Zoning, Planning and Development Commission to deny (failure to approve or deny) application for zoning variation to allow construction of an oversized garage (34 X 34). Revised plans were resubmitted along with a letter of appeal / reconsideration which was reviewed by City Council. Alderman Phillips made a motion seconded by Alderman Contreras to approve the appeal.
