

BURBANK POLICE NOTICE

The Burbank Police Department requests your cooperation in implementing additional health prevention strategies to reduce risk to the community and our employees during the Covid-19 crisis.

The Burbank Police Department will only be responding to high priority or emergency calls, including but not limited to:

- Violent crimes or crimes against persons injured or endangered
- Domestic-related incidents, either in progress or suspect/offender is still on the scene
- Incidents where evidence needs to be collected/processed (ie..Robberies, Burglaries)
- Serious motor vehicle incidents
- Or incidents that a supervisor deems necessary for police response

Low priority calls that are non-emergencies, informational calls, minor property crimes, ordinance violations will still call 911. An officer will call you back to take your report via telephone.

We ask that you refrain from coming to the Burbank Police Department to file a low priority incident, or if you are currently experiencing flu like symptoms or traveled abroad within the last 14 days. Please call 911 from your residence.

Thank you for your cooperation and together we will get through this crisis.
