September 25, 2024**

<b>CALL TO ORDER</b>	The meeting of September 25, 2024 was called to order by Mayor Dan M. Foy at 7:30 PM in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79 <sup>th</sup> Street Burbank, Il.
<b>ROLL CALL</b>	A roll call by Clerk Gilgenberg indicated the following members present: Ald. Barb Gagle, , Ald. Sheri Gustafson, Ald. Claude Haerr, Ald. John Pacella, Ald. Mitchell Piznarski, Ald.
