



**REGULAR MEETING

April 10, 2024**

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting of April 10, 2024 was called to order by Mayor Dan M. Foy at 7:30 PM in the Council Chambers at 6530 West 79th Street Burbank, Il.
- ROLL CALL** A roll call by Clerk Gilgenberg indicated the following members present: Ald. Barb Gagle, Ald. Robert Contreras, Ald. Sheri Gustafson, Ald. Claude Haerr, Ald. John Pacella, Ald. Mitchell Piznarski, Ald. Thomas Phillips, Mayor Dan Foy, Clerk David Gilgenberg and Treasurer Dave Viverito. Also in attendance: City Attorney Vince Cainkar.
- PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE** Mayor Foy asked all to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.
- JOURNAL** Mayor Foy asked for a motion to approve the minutes of March 13, 2024. The motion was made by Ald. Contreras and seconded by Ald. Piznarski with unanimous approval by voice vote and so declared by the Chair.

**Citizens
Report**

Lori Duncan of 7919 Parkside and Sharon Hildebrand of 7915 Parkside expressed their concerns to City Council regarding the permit parking on their block specifically requesting that the time restriction be removed from the permit parking. The concerned residents offered several complaints about the parking in the area as well as how the church on 80th and Parkside are blocking parkways and alleys. Follow up concerns were raised by resident Noel Marroquin of 7924 Parkside. Mayor Foy instructed Chief Garcia to put a special watch on the area. In addition, Mayor Foy asked Alderman Haerr to talk to the residents in his ward about these complaints and how lifting the time restriction might impact everyone on the block.
